

**ABIH CERTIFICATION MAINTENANCE POINTS (CM's)**  
**Fiscal Year 2009<sup>1</sup>**  
**October 1, 2008**

Although CM points for the new fiscal year were not available at press time, we anticipate that points will be obtained for courses listed in this table. Updates to this table will be made as approval is received.

The OSHA Training Institute (OTI) requests ABIH approval for Certification Maintenance (CM) points only for course sessions sponsored by the OSHA Training Institute and listed in our course catalogs. We do not request CM point approval for courses that are given at the request of OSHA Regions, Area Offices, other Federal agencies, State or local governments, or private companies, even when the instruction is provided by instructors of OTI. Such courses may involve variations in length and/or content from that of similar courses given by OTI. The requesting agency or company is considered the sponsor of such courses and may request CM point approval directly from ABIH. Alternately, individual CIHs may request CM point approval from ABIH.

Courses offered by the OSHA Training Institute are approved for either **Industrial Hygiene (IH) CM points** or for **Safety (S) CM points**.

<sup>1</sup>**NOTE—CM Points for OTI Web Seminars:** The approval numbers in this table are for the Fiscal Year 2009, with the exception of the OTI Web Seminars, which are the last entry in the table. The OTI Web Seminars are covered by a single approval number that is good for Calendar Year 2008; ABIH diplomates may accumulate points for the Web Seminars based on their total attendance time during the current Calendar Year only. Web Seminar hours approved for **Industrial Hygiene (IH)** credit must be totaled separately from those approved for **Safety (S)** credit.

<sup>2</sup> Hours toward IH (industrial hygiene) points are accumulated separately from hours toward S (safety ) points.  
Less than 3 hours (either industrial hygiene OR safety, counted separately) = 0 points  
At least 3 hours but less than 6 hours = 0.5 point  
At least 6 hours but less than 9 hours = 1.0 point  
At least 9 hours but less than 12 hours = 1.5 points  
12 hours = 2.0 points.
