1.	Have the contents of first aid kits to be used at the jobsite been inspected for sufficiency of items?	<b>Y</b>	<b>N</b>
2.	If a clinic, hospital or physician is not reasonably accessible to the jobsite in terms of time and distance, has a jobsite employee been certified in first aid from the American Red Cross or similar organization and able to render first aid?	<b>Y</b>	<b>N</b>
3.	Will emergency telephone numbers of medical care providers be ascertained and conspicuously posted at the jobsite?	<b>Y</b>	<b>N</b>
4.	Will a cellular telephone or two-way radio be available so that workers may call for medical care providers in an emergency?	<b>Y</b>	<b>N</b>
5.	If a worker could be exposed to injurious corrosive materials at the jobsite, will equipment be available for immediate emergency use for quick drenching of the body or flushing of eyes?	<b>Y</b>	<b>N</b>
6.	Is any worker on the job trained in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR)?	<b>Y</b>	<b>N</b>
7.	Are emergency telephone numbers readily accessible to workers?	<b>Y</b>	<b>N</b>
