**Whistleblower
Protection Programs**

OSHA law prohibits employers from retaliating against workers for engaging in protected activities relating to safety and health laws in the workplace, such as participating in OSHA inspections, complaining to the employer, the union, or any other government agency about safety and health risks at work.

If you believe that your employer retaliated against you for exercising your legal rights as an employee under occupational safety and health law, contact OSHA as soon as possible, since your complaint must be filed within 30 days of the alleged discrimination.
