Program Overview for April 20, 2010 – Health Hazards in Construction – Have You Evaluated the Airborne and Noise Hazards on Your Work Sites?

Are your employees overexposed to dust on your construction sites? Are they overexposed to noise on the job? What steps have you taken to protect them? OSHA has standards for airborne hazards and a noise standard. This session will cover OSHA’s requirements for employees exposed to dusts and other airborne hazards and noise.

April 20, 2010 – John Dimos, CIH. – John Dimos is an industrial hygienist who has spent his working career either evaluating employees’ exposures to health hazards in workplaces or showing others how it is done. He currently is a consultant for many clients, including the Chicago Safety Council, helping them conduct baseline analyses of employee exposures and developing air and noise monitoring programs.
