### Program Overview for May 25, 2010 – Fall Protection: The Good, the Bad and the Ugly

This session will focus on the installation of perimeter protection guardrails and hole covers and the use of fall arrest equipment. It will focus on common mistakes made in the use of these fall protection measures. Proper installation of guardrails and covers will be discussed including materials used, sizes, strengths, deflection and marking requirements. The proper use of fall arrest equipment will also be discussed including use of anchorages, fitting of harnesses, calculation of potential fall distances, suspension trauma concerns and rescue.

He is a registered professional engineer with over 32 years of construction and safety experience.
