**February 23 Speaker:** Brian Sturtecky, OSHA Construction Safety Specialist. Mr. Sturtecky started his OSHA career as a compliance officer in the Chicago area and is currently working in the Chicago Regional Office overseeing all construction enforcement activity in Wisconsin, Illinois and Ohio. Mr. Sturtecky is the person the Wisconsin construction compliance officers call when they have an enforcement question and helps area office staff develop inspection case files. He will be taking questions.
