OSHA 10 Hour Construction Safety and Health

Course Description

This 10-hour Construction Safety Course is intended for entry level participants and is intended to provide instruction on a variety of construction safety and health standards. Course topics will include: Introduction to OSHA, Electrical Safety, Fall Protection, Ladder Safety, Excavation Safety, Scaffold Safety, Materials Handling, Forklift Safety, Personal Protective Equipment and Permit-Required Confined Space Entry. Upon successful completion of this course participants will receive OSHA Construction Safety and Health 10-Hour Card. *1.0 CE US.*

Focused Advanced Supervisor Training ~ FAST (English Only)

Course Description

This track will contain five advanced sessions over one and one-half days. These classes will enable participants to identify hazards in both commercial and residential jobsite settings, provide leadership on the jobsite skills, and educate workers in the prevention of hazards. Topics will include: Fall Protection, Excavation, Leadership, NFPA 70e "Standard for Electrical Safety in the Workplace" and Work Zone Safety.
