1.	Have hard hats, safety glasses, goggles and face shields been inspected for wear, damage, proper fit and function prior to delivery to or use at the jobsite?	Y	N
2.	Are sufficient quantities and types of PPE necessary for the job available to protect all workers on the jobsite?	Y	N
3.	Are workers instructed in the proper use, selection and care of PPE that is required on this job?	Y	N

4.	Are workers exposed to hazards wearing appropriate PPE to protect them from injuries?	Y	N
