KNOW YOUR RIGHTS

- You may request a copy of the safety standards, rules, regulations and requirements which your employer should have readily available at the workplace.
- You may file a discrimination complaint within 30 days if you believe to have punished or discriminated against for exercising your rights to health and safety or for refusing to work (not guaranteed by the OSHA Act) before imminent danger of death or severe injury within an insufficient amount of time for OSHA to inspect said case.
- The floor of every workplace should be kept clean and, where possible, dry.

KNOW YOUR RIGHTS

- Every working place, floor and passageway shall be kept free of protruding nails, splinters, holes, and loose wood.
- All work stations, corridors, storerooms, and service rooms must be kept clean, tidy and sanitized.
- Extension ladders should be used at a 4 to 1 pitch (1.2 to .3 m). For every 4 ft. (1.2 m) in height, the bottom of the ladder should be 1 ft. (.3 m) away from the wall or similar structure.
