Topics of Discussion	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. If an entity wholly owned by an NRTL owns a certification mark, and the NRTL uses that mark for its NRTL certifications, the entity owned by the NRTL could no longer use the mark for any purpose, including marketing or advertisement.</li> <li>2. Any mark owned by an NRTL, and used for its NRTL certifications, would need to be clearly distinguishable from the mark of another entity owned or affiliated with the NRTL.</li> <li>3. Each NRTL would need to add a unique identifier to its certification mark to signify testing and certification conducted under the NRTL Program.</li> </ol>
