



SAFETY PHOTO SCAVENGER HUNT

30 mins – Majestic Rotunda and Entire Venue

Key Competencies: *Knowledge of locations of AEDs, Fire Extinguishers, Pull Stations * Increased awareness of common work-place hazards and examples of how to resolve * Knowledge of location of OSHA Board and employee resources * Team building amongst team members

Equipment Needed: Scavenger Hunt List for each group

Space Set-Up Notes: Doors to common event spaces should be unlocked

FACILITATOR INSTRUCTIONS:

- Break the group into teams of 5 – 6 people per group
- Inform participants to select a group leader who will be responsible for capturing the photos they are taking
- Advise the participants that points will be awarded for each photo task completed (designated point values are on their “Scavenger Hunt List” sheets) and that there are additional points for creativity.
- Call forward the group leaders and synchronize watches and advise they have 11 minutes to complete as many tasks as possible. When their time is up, all group members must report back to the Majestic Rotunda. Late groups will receive a 5 point reduction for every minute late. *Iterate that staff members should not risk their own safety while completing this activity.*
- Hand out 1 Scavenger Hunt List to each group and begin countdown
- Facilitate the debrief upon completion of the scavenger hunt
- Award winning team that achieved the most points

DEBRIEF / DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

1. Were there any challenges that a team did not know how to respond to? If so, what is the appropriate response?
2. Did any of the teams respond to a prompt differently than another team? If so, which responses are accurate or preferred?
3. As a whole, do team members feel prepared to handle these situations in a live event situation? What resources, information, or additional training would be helpful?
4. Open discussion

Scavenger Hunt List

1. A patron has spilled their entire cup of beer on a non-carpeted floor. What tool(s) do you ensure is in place. (5 pts)
2. A child is unconscious. How do you respond and what tool(s) do you need? (15 pts)
3. Roasted nuts have caught on fire in the roasting pan at the mezzanine bar. Identify the nearest fire extinguisher, pull station and egress route. (5 pts)
4. Locate at least one of the OSHA employee information board. (10 pts)
5. What tool(s) helps you “beat the heat” at the stage door? (5 pts)
6. Reflecting on your experiences here, have you noticed common trip hazards? If so, re-create that trip hazard and take a picture. After, resolve the hazard and take another picture. (15 pts)
7. A valet team member has overheated and is feeling dizzy. Create an image that snapshots your first responses. Be sure to include the tools utilized in the photo. (15 pts)
