
Hazard Communication Pre-Test Answer Key

- 1. Under the OSH Act of 1970 employers must find and correct safety and health hazards.
- 2. Employers must also inform employees about chemical hazards through training, labels, alarms, color-coded systems, chemical information sheets and other methods.
- 3. Employers must provide workers **information and training** (in a language workers can understand) about chemical and other hazards, methods to prevent harm, and OSHA standards that apply to their workplace.
- 4. Workers have a right to **copies of test results** done to find and measure hazards in the workplace.
