# TOP INJURY EVENTS Specialty Trade Contractors

#### **Fatal Events**

- Falls to lower level
- Roadway motor vehicle incidents
- Struck by objects or equipment

#### **Nonfatal Events**

- Falls, slips, or trips
- Struck by object
- Overexertion: lifting or lowering
