Find and Fix Hazards



Establish an ongoing process that helps better identify and control sources of potential injuries or illnesses.

- Spotlight hazards and controls
- Engage workers with challenges and contests
- · Conduct analysis to identify hazards
- Identify safety and health processes and procedures
