Support Peer-to-Peer Recognition of Safe Work

Managers are usually responsible for recognizing safe workers in the workplace, but a peer-to-peer recognition program like this challenge can get more workers involved. Use the Safety Shout-Out challenge to encourage workers to recognize each other for putting safety first.



SAFETY SHOUT-OUT

Peer-to-peer recognition can:

- Make workers more aware of daily safety actions and activities
- Provide immediate and timely recognition of workers
- Reinforce collaboration, teamwork, and support between workers
- Encourage informal safety conversations and learning between workers



Safety recognition programs are an important part of safety and health programs. Recognition programs motivate companies, teams, and people to work safely.
